

## **SUBSTANCE**

### **Rule of law**

Allegations of breach of the rule of law must be related to a particular right and dealt with contextually, and so cannot be treated in abstract by the Court. Accordingly, where allegations of a breach of the rule of law are not related to a specific right, then the claim is not substantiated the issue of breach of the rule of law was held not to have arisen where it is not substantiated (*Tanganyika Law Society, The Legal and Human Rights Centre v The United Republic of Tanzania*, application 009/2011; *Reverend Christopher R. Mtikila v The United Republic of Tanzania*, application 011/2011, judgment, 14 June 2013, para 120).
