Jurisdiction and access are related

The issue of jurisdiction is considered to be closely related to access in terms of articles 3, 5 and 6 of the Protocol establishing the Court, and so may be considered at four levels - the personal, material, temporal and geographical levels (*Tanganyika Law Society, The Legal and Human Rights Centre v The United Republic of Tanzania*, application 009/2011; *Reverend Christopher R.
