Compensation for moral damage

Moral damages is often assumed by international courts in cases of human rights violations (*Konate*, Reparations, para 58). Similarly in the *Zongo* reparations case, the Court held that the proof of moral damages may be assumed automatic consequence of human rights violations without the need to adduce any further proof (*Zongo*, Reparations, para 55).

The Court will assess moral damages equitably taking into consideration the circumstance of each case (*Zongo*, Reparations, para 61).
